



### **School Uniform**

Students were given the chance to redesign the school uniform a year or so ago and opted to keep it as it is now. Other than the tie, available from Reception, we do not specify particular brands of clothing or supply it all in-house because our parents tell us that they prefer to shop around for items.

#### **School uniform is:**

- Black traditional school trousers (please no tight stretchy trousers / leggings or a denim style) or a skirt that is no more than 4cm above the knee.
- Plain white shirt long enough to be tucked in and buttons to the neck
- School tie
- Plain black v-neck jumper or cardigan.
- A black blazer is optional. Some students like to wear them, finding the pockets very handy! Others prefer to wear the jumper / cardigan. It really is down to personal preference.
- Footwear has to be plain black and can be either a shoe or trainer. No logos or colours other than black allowed. And no high heels either please!

#### **PE Kit**

- The AMF blue T-shirt needs to be bought from Reception.
- Students will also need plain black shorts and tracksuit bottoms.
- The AMF sports top is optional and available from Reception, but no other sweatshirt top is to be worn during PE lessons.
- Socks must be white.
- Trainers / boots can be of any design.

#### **Jewellery**

Pupils with pierced ears may wear one simple stud per ear. No hoops or sleepers are permitted for health & safety reasons. No rings please.

#### **Make-up**

Only discreet make-up may be worn.
